SUGGESTED COURSE ELECTIVES

MPH students in the concentration of Epidemiology can choose a maximum of six credit hours for elective courses. The student should read the course descriptions in the graduate catalogue, speak with the professor assigned to a course requiring consent of the instructor or prerequisites, and inquire about course content in relation to Public Health.

If a course of potential interest is not on this listing, approval must be obtained from one's epidemiology academic advisor prior to enrollment. Limited opportunities for a directed independent study in cooperation with a faculty member may be possible. Elective courses are to be selected in consultation with one's academic advisor.
