The UT department of Nutrition offers a Bachelor of Science degree in nutrition with concentration in Biomedical. Ours is one of the largest programs in Tennessee and is academically rigorous so that our graduates are prepared for a successful career. The Biomedical concentration provides an outstanding foundation for pursuing careers in pharmacy, nursing, medicine, veterinary medicine, dentistry and other biomedical sciences, as well as graduate study and research careers in nutrition and related areas. This concentration includes courses such as biology and genetics, required for pre-health majors and for graduate study in the sciences.

Nutrition: Biomedical majors must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA and complete all NUTR classes with a C or better.
